

**TOWN OF WHITEWOOD
BYLAW NO.7/98**

The Council of the Town of Whitewood, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw shall be known and referred to as the "General Penalty Bylaw" of the Town of Whitewood.
2. Where a given bylaw does not include provision for a set fine/penalty for an infraction against that bylaw, the fine/penalty shall be not more than \$2,000. (two thousand dollars) in the case of an individual and not more than \$5,000. (five thousand dollars) in the case of a corporation.
3. In default of an amount charged in accordance with Section 2, above, the person convicted may be imprisoned for a term of not more than 90 (ninety) days, unless the fine or penalty or fine and licence fee are paid sooner.
4. All monies collected as a result of a fine/penalty under the terms of any bylaw of the Town of Whitewood shall, unless otherwise provided for, belong to the Town of Whitewood for public use and form a part of the general revenues of the town.
5. Bylaw No.4/75 of the Town of Whitewood is hereby repealed.
6. This bylaw shall come into effect immediately following third reading and adoption by the Council of the Town of Whitewood.

Read a third time and adopted by Council this 21st day of April, 1998.
