

BYLAW NO. 13/97

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF WHITWOOD, IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN, TO CONTROL THE DISPOSAL OF SCRAP TIRES.

WHEREAS the Saskatchewan Scrap Tire Corporation has implemented a program in Saskatchewan to recycle scrap tires;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Whitewood deems it environmentally beneficial to ban the disposal of tires in its landfill;

THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Whitewood, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. It is unlawful to deposit scrap tires in the landfill owned and operated by the Town of Whitewood and located within the Rural Municipality of Silverwood No.123.
2. It is unlawful to deposit scrap tires on any property in the Town of Whitewood unless specifically designated by resolution of Council as a tire marshalling yard.
3. A person or an incorporated entity contravening the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and upon summary conviction shall be liable to the penalty provided for by the general penalty bylaw of the municipality.
