

BYLAW NUMBER 3-1971

The Council of the Town of Whitewood enacts a bylaw respecting the prevention of disturbances, and fires.

- (1) No person shall advertise, keep for sale, or sell any form of fire works or firecrackers of any kind, without first obtaining a permit from the fire chief and the chief of police.
- (2) No person shall set off firecrackers, or fire works, within the town limits, without first obtaining a permit from the fire chief and the chief of police.

Any person found guilty of an infraction of this bylaw, shall on summary conviction be liable to a fine of not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) or not more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) in addition to the costs, and in default of payment to imprisonment in a common jail for a period not exceeding ten days, unless said penalty and costs are sooner paid.
