Canskate is Skate Canada's learn-to-skate program, designed for beginners of all ages. The program is great for those interested in participating in figure skating, hockey, or those who just want to skate for fun. When you sign up for Canskate you will be in a program that focuses on fun, participation, and basic skill development. Lessons are given in a group format and led by an NCCP certified professional coach who is assisted by trained Program Assistants. Skaters progress at their own rate and coaches make sessions active using teaching aids, music and a wide variety of circuits and games that create a fun environment and promote learning. We run the "New" Canskate program which focuses on Agility, Balance, and Control at each of the 6 badge levels. This program is great as it combines general skating skills, with hockey and figure skating skills, which allows us to offer one program that can be enjoyed by skaters of all different disciplines.

Bridging is an opportunity for Canskaters in Stage 4 and higher to participate in both Canskate and Starskate. Skaters receive an extra hour of ice time before or after Canskate in which they receive more advanced lessons and time to learn to practice skills on their own.

Starskate The STAR in Starskate stands for Skills, Tests, Achievement, and Recognition. Starskate offers opportunities for skaters of all ages to develop fundamental figure skating skills in the areas of ice dance, skating skills, free skate and interpretive skating. This program teaches figure skating skills in a group and/or private lesson format in a progressive and sequential manner and includes specifically designed awards and incentives. Skaters have the opportunity to take Skate Canada Tests through a nationally standardized testing system.

Head Coach – Kennedy Sippola: NCCP trained Regional Coach, skating for 16 years, a program assistant in Whitewood for 5 years and coached under Sheena for 2 years.

We have accepted the chance to run the Soup and Sandwich during the Craft Show again this year on Sat. Oct 13th we did this last year and it was an easy fundraiser. All families will be required to participate and details will be discussed closer to the date. (for anyone that was there last year we will make sure we have enough food)

Added to registration will be **\$100 post dated cheque** for Jan.15/19 which is payment for 1 book of mandatory **Skate Canada SK fundraising tickets**. These will be handed out before Christmas and due in January. You will recoup this money when you sell your ticket books. We will not deposit the cheques until after Christmas once all the tickets have been collected.

Option – your registration may be split into 2 cheques dated for Sept 15th and December 15th 2018.

*Each family is required to participate in the rink kitchen program. Skating families will be scheduled for 5 kitchen shifts throughout the skating year (subject to change). We require 5 **\$80 UNDATED** cheques to be collected at registration. Any cheques that are not in by Oct 31st, 2018 are subject to a penalty of \$50. If a check is NFS upon deposit a \$50 penalty will apply. These cheques will be held and **ONLY** cashed if you do not show up or arrange for someone to work your scheduled kitchen rink shift (Patsy will arrange all hires). Those wishing to purchase a "buy out" on kitchen duty are required to pay \$400 prior to October 31st 2018.*

More info about kitchen shifts will be emailed out at a later date.
