Canskate is Skate Canada's learn-to-skate program, designed for beginners of all ages. The program is great for those interested in participating in figure skating, hockey, or those who just want to skate for fun. When you sign up for Canskate you will be in a program that focuses on fun, participation, and basic skill development. Lessons are given in a group format and led by an NCCP certified professional coach who is assisted by trained Program Assistants. Skaters progress at their own rate and coaches make sessions active using teaching aids, music and a wide variety of circuits and games that create a fun environment and promote learning. We run the "New" Canskate program which focuses on Agility, Balance, and Control at each of the 6 badge levels. This program is great as it combines general skating skills, with hockey and figure skating skills, which allows us to offer one program that can be enjoyed by skaters of all different disciplines.

Canskate will run: Thursdays 6:15- 7pm; Sundays 2-2:45pm

Bridging is an opportunity for Canskaters in Stage 4 and higher to participate in both Canskate and Starskate. Skaters receive an extra hour of ice time before or after Canskate in which they receive more advanced lessons and time to learn to practice skills on their own.

Bridging will run: Thursdays 5-7pm; Sundays 2-4pm

Starskate The STAR in Starskate stands for Skills, Tests, Achievement, and Recognition. Starskate offers opportunities for skaters of all ages to develop fundamental figure skating skills in the areas of ice dance, skating skills, free skate and interpretive skating. This program teaches figure skating skills in a group and/or private lesson format in a progressive and sequential manner and includes specifically designed awards and incentives. Skaters have the opportunity to take Skate Canada Tests through a nationally standardized testing system.

Starskate will run: Tuesdays 4-5:30pm; Sundays 2:45- 5pm; with optional skate on Thursdays during Bridging

Coaching – There are some changes to coaching this year, we have hired certified Provincial Coach Rhys McAlpine (head coach in Esterhazy) as our Starskate coach. Kelsey Perry is continuing on as our Canskate coach, she has recently completed her certification to become a Canskate Coach.

Option – your registration may be split into 2 cheques dated for Sept 15th and December 15th 2019.

We have accepted the chance to run the Soup and Sandwich during the Craft Show again this year on Sat. Oct 19th we did this last year and it was an easy fundraiser and is MANDATORY for all families to participate, details will be discussed closer to the date. ***Our second fundraiser is Mom's Pantry. This year we are requiring families to sell a minimum of \$200 worth of product or buyout for \$75.

Each family is required to participate in the rink kitchen program. Skating families will be scheduled for 5 kitchen shifts throughout the skating year (subject to change). We require 5 \$100 **UNDATED** cheques to be collected at registration. Any cheques that are not in by Oct 31st, 2019 are subject to a penalty of \$50. If a check is NFS upon deposit a \$50 penalty will apply. These cheques will be held and **ONLY** cashed if you do not show up or arrange for someone to work your scheduled kitchen rink shift (Patsy will arrange all hires). Those wishing to purchase a "buy out" on kitchen duty are required to pay \$500 prior to October 31st 2019. **More info about kitchen shifts will be emailed out at a later date.**
