

**TOWN OF WHITEWOOD
BYLAW NO. 07/06**

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF WHITEWOOD TO CONTROL THE OWNERSHIP OF ANIMALS

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Whitewood in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be referenced as "The Animal Ownership Bylaw".
2. For the purpose of this bylaw, the expression:
 - "even-toed hoofed animals" shall mean mammals having reduced number of functional toes and that rest their weight equally on the third and fourth toes of each foot i.e. include but not restricted to pigs, deer, cattle, antelope, camels, llamas, sheep, goats, giraffes.
 - "odd-toed hoofed mammals" shall mean mammals having a reduced number of toes, each encased in a protective horny sheath or hoof, and the weight is carried mainly by the middle digit of each foot- i.e. include but are not restricted to horses, asses, mules, zebras, tapirs, rhinoceroses.
 - "poultry" shall mean domesticated birds keep for eggs or meat i.e. includes chickens, turkeys, ducks, geese, quail, guinea, fowl, pheasants, pigeons, ostriches.
 - "Municipality" shall mean the Town of Whitewood
 - "rodent" shall mean a mammal with strong incisors and no canine teeth i.e. included but not restricted to rabbit, chinchilla
3. No person shall herd even-toed hoofed, odd-toed hoofed animals and poultry at any time within the limits of the Municipality.
4. No person shall graze even-toed hoofed, odd-toed hoofed animals and poultry at any time within the limits of the Municipality.
5. No person shall shall keep even-toed hoofed, odd-toed hoofed animals and Poultry within the limits of the Municipality except for the Vet Clinic for the purpose of treatment.
6. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to a fine of first offense \$500.00 and second and subsequence offenses \$1,000.00.
