<i>AmendSMB;</i> <i>Consolidate</i> 2395/2026	Brule, Jones – WHEREAS the Town of Whitewood has been approved for two capital loans in the amounts of \$854,000 and \$1,000,000 for the purpose of upgrading the municipal sewage lagoon; AND WHEREAS the Town of Whitewood has an existing capital loan for the Municipal lift station, with an outstanding principal balance of \$237,867; AND WHEREAS Council deems it advisable and in the best interest of the municipality to consolidate these three borrowings into a single loan; AND WHEREAS Section 162 of <i>The Municipalities Act</i> authorizes municipalities to borrow money for capital expenditures by resolution of council; THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT application be made to the Local Government Committee for permission to borrow the consolidated sum of \$2,091,687 in the year 2026, repayable over a period of 15 years, for the purpose of consolidating the aforementioned loans into one borrowing; AND THAT the said debt shall be repaid in annually installments of \$139,445.80 at a fixed interest rate of 6.45%; AND THAT this resolution be submitted as part of the borrowing application to the Local Government Committee.
